Dear Parent/Guardian,

Mirboo North Secondary College is looking forward to another positive year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of the school's payment arrangements for 2021.

The college makes decisions which ensure that all students can access a broad range of learning opportunities that support their expectations and promote their aspirations as they move through the education system. Parent contribution, in all forms, assists the college to provide an enriched learning and teaching program for every student and is highly valued by the college community.

Learning and teaching programs vary based on local needs and circumstances and reflect the college's priorities, decisions and resources. This, in turn, informs the parent payment charges approved by the college council.

The Education and Training Reform Act 2006 provides for instruction in the standard curriculum program to be free to all students in government colleges. College council is responsible for developing and approving college-level parent payment charges and can request payments from parents under three categories only: Essential Student Learning Items, Optional Items and Voluntary Contributions.

- **Essential Student Learning Items:** Essential Student Learning Items are those items, activities or services which the college deems as essential to support student learning of the standard curriculum. These are items that the college considers essential for all students, and for which students take possession. The attached 2021 parent payment fee schedule provides an itemised list, ensuring more detailed information and greater transparency for families

- **Optional:** Optional Items are those items, activities or services that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are offered in addition to the standard curriculum program. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

- **Voluntary Contributions:** School councils can invite parents and guardians to make a voluntary contribution to support the college to continue to provide for class sets, materials for practical classes and general resources. Parent contributions assist the school to provide an enriched learning and teaching program for every student and Mirboo North Secondary College continues to welcome your voluntary contribution to support our school.

The school appreciates that families may experience financial difficulty and offers support options which include State School Relief, the Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund (CSEF) and payment plans.
